Field Trip Lunch Guide

- As a rule, outside food and beverages are not allowed at Discovery Park of America unless it is to satisfy religious or medical requirements. This means students may not bring a sack lunch prepared at home and eat it inside the museum or park.
- With prior approval, public schools may arrange to bring in food prepared by their school cafeteria for students on a field trip and DPA will arrange for them to have a comfortable place to eat.
- Food may be brought in by anyone to satisfy religious or medical dietary requirements.
- Lunches purchased from an outside restaurant will not be permitted into Discovery Park of America. (E.g. McDonald's, Subway, Wendy's, etc.)
- Many lunch options are available for purchase at Sabin's Café or Eats 'n' Treats, our onsite food providers.
- Chaperones on a field trip can order a student lunch through Sabin's Café to eat with their children, or lunch can be ordered ala carte from the Sabin's Café or Eat 'n' Treats menu. All should be advised that food ordered ala carte may not be ready immediately as it is prepared to order.
